The Octave of Easter

Masses will be offered each day, Monday through Saturday, during the Octave of Easter at 12:10 pm at Immaculate Conception, including 9:00 am on Friday at Sacred Heart. This year the First Friday and the First Saturday of April fall within the Octave of Easter and the usual devotions will follow each of those Masses. Check the bulletin for more specific information.

First Holy Communion

The youth of our parish who have prepared for their First Holy Communion will receive the Sacrament for the first time on April 7th, the Second Sunday of Easter (Divine Mercy Sunday), at the 11:00 am Mass at Immaculate Conception. A reception will follow.

Divine Mercy Sunday

Commemoration of the Divine Mercy 3:00 pm Immaculate Conception

The commemoration will begin with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament followed by the Gospel of the day and a brief homily. The Chaplet of Divine Mercy will be sung followed by Benediction. At the dismissal all may come forward for a blessing with relic of St. Faustina and the veneration of the image of Divine Mercy. A meal will follow the commemoration.
