The Octave of Easter

Masses will be offered each day, Monday through Thursday, during the Octave of Easter at 12:10 pm at Immaculate Conception. Confessions will be available each day at 11:30 am and Eucharist Adoration will resume the following week. The Mass on Friday will be offered at 9:00 am at Sacred Heart followed by a Holy Hour of Eucharistic Adoration.

First Holy Communion

The youth of our parish who have prepared for their First Holy Communion will receive the Sacrament for the first time on April 27th, the Second Sunday of Easter (Divine Mercy Sunday), at the 9:00 am Mass at Sacred Heart and the 11:00 am Mass at Immaculate Conception. A reception will follow.

Divine Mercy Sunday

Second Sunday (Octave Day) of Easter
April 27th
Sunday Mass times as usual.

Commemoration of the Divine Mercy
3:00 pm Immaculate Conception

The commemoration will begin with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament followed by the Gospel of the day and a brief homily. The Chaplet of Divine Mercy will be sung followed by Benediction. At the dismissal all may come forward for a blessing with relic of St. Faustina and the veneration of the image of Divine Mercy. A meal will follow the commemoration.

The Chaplet of Divine Mercy Novena

The novena of the Divine Mercy begins on Good Friday. Leaflets with the novena prayers can be found at the entrance of the church.
